Host: Dr. William Hayes

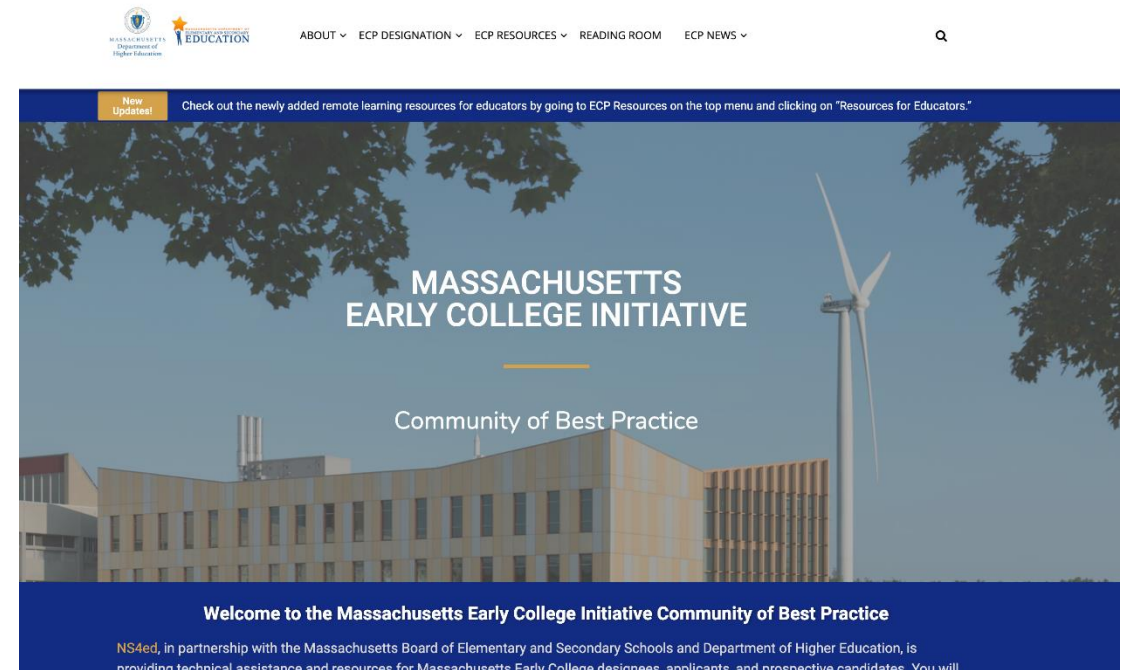
